THE QUALITY BEEF DAY COMMITTEE IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCIDENTS

The following will be observed and enforced during the show-

1. 4-H and FFA animals will be shown together and at the same time as open class animals.

2. No 4-H or FFA Champions will show against open class animals for Breed Championship.

3. 4-H or FFA cannot compete against Open Class exhibitors with the same animal.

4. Showmanship participants must show their own animal. No bulls allowed in showmanship.

5. All 4-H or FFA market steers and heifers will be placed In classes as determined by the Executive Committee.

6. Market Steers and Market Heifers will show for Grand and Reserve Market Beef.

7. Breed Champions will show for Supreme and Reserve Supr. Heifer.

8. All persons who attend or participate in the show do so at their own risk. The Marshall Co. Extension Service, or Quality Beef Day Committee assumes no liability for any accidents that may occur.

9. The Marshall Co. Extension Service, or Quality Beef Day Committee assumes no liability for loss or injury of livestock due to theft, mysterious disappearance, sickness, or act of God.

10. <u>No</u> dogs or blocking chutes allowed in building.

11. All OUTSIDE bedding must be removed and hauled away by the exhibitor. IINSIDE bedding must be pulled away from the panels.

12. Any animal may be used for the livestock judging contest.

13. All purebred breeding animals must be accompanied by registration papers, and all purebred market animals must have breed certification in order to show in breed classes. *Breed registration and certification are subject to check by the show committee. Exhibitors must present breed registration papers and breed certification at check in.*
