

## How To Submit 4-H Day Presentation Videos

This process must be **completed by 8:30am on March 8<sup>th</sup>** in order for your video presentation to be judged.

Go to <https://tinyurl.com/MsCo4HDay2021> to input your name, club, presentation type, and the link for your video. You will do this for each presentation you are entering.

Presentations can be uploaded to Qualtrics, but is limited to size restrictions. If a file is too large to upload it should be uploaded to YouTube. Presentations will need to be uploaded to YouTube as an unlisted video. This will allow us to share the link with judges so presentations can be evaluated but the video.

### What is an unlisted YouTube video?

Videos you upload to YouTube as “unlisted” are **completely private** and visible only to people with the URL (i.e., the web link to your video). The video does not appear in search results, and it is not shown in subscriptions, “What’s Next”, or “Recommended”. This prevents the video from being visible to anyone who doesn’t have your specific URL. When you upload your video and get your URL, that URL will only be shared with 4-H staff and judges. Once your video has been judged and you receive your results, you can delete your video from YouTube if you want.

If you record your video with a smartphone or tablet, you can also upload a video directly from that device.

- Download the YouTube app, sign in using your Google account, tap the plus sign at the bottom of the screen, and follow the prompts to upload your video.
- **Make sure to choose “Unlisted” under “Privacy”** (the default is Public).
- Title your video with your name and presentation type.
- When the upload is finished, get the link to your video by tapping the menu icon (3 dots) next to the video (you may need to find your video in your “library” at bottom of your screen), tap “Share”, and then “Copy Link”. Paste the link into a note or somewhere else you can find it.

If you aren’t comfortable using YouTube or are having issues, contact the Extension Office to arrange an alternate method to submit your video. We don’t want this to be a barrier that prevents youth from participating.

Video presentations will be judged the week of March 8<sup>th</sup> and results will be posted to the Marshall County Extension Facebook page and to the Marshall County 4-H website by March 15<sup>th</sup>. Ribbons and scoresheets will be sent to participants.
