NOW COLLECTING:

ALUMINUM CANS: Beverage cans - CLEAN. Please separate from tin cans.

ALUMINUM FOIL & PIE PLATES - Foil pie plates and trays and **CLEAN** used foil. Please have the cans and other aluminum separated.

BOOKS: Separate telephone, hardback and paperback books.

TIN CANS: Rinsed. Labels do not need to be removed. Expired license plates and wire coat hangers are recycled with tin cans.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD: Has wavy sections in the middle and does not include cereal boxes, shoeboxes, or any other kind of smooth, pressed paper. Flattened. Staples and tape need not be removed. Only clean cardboard. No oil stains or pizza boxes.

GLASS: Must be clean (NO FOOD RESIDUE). Labels do not need to be removed. UNBROKEN. Remove all lids (metal lids may go with tin cans, throw away the plastic lids). There are 3 categories of glass - 1. Clear; 2. Brown; 3. Blue and green may be combined. Please keep the categories separate. No windows, mirrors, dishes, light bulbs or broken glass.

MILK JUGS: Rinsed! Remove and discard the plastic lids.

#1 AND #2 PLASTIC: These containers must have a #1 or #2 in the recycling symbol somewhere on the container, usually on the bottom. No lids. The containers must be clean.

PLASTIC DRINK BOTTLES: Must be clean. Remove lids. Needs to be separated from other plastic items.

#3 THRU #7 PLASTIC: NO longer accepted.

NEWSPAPER: Put in brown paper sacks, box, plastic bags or in another organized fashion. Please don't bring loose newspapers! Slicks do need to be removed.

MAGAZINES, CATALOGS, SLICK PAPER PUBLICATIONS: Please bring them in an organized fashion, such as in a disposable bag or box.

PLASTIC SHOPPING BAGS

NO CHEMICAL OR MOTOR OIL BOTTLES WILL BE ACCEPTED!

PLEASE SEE OTHER SIDE FOR ADDITIONAL ITEMS TO BE RECYCLED.

OFFICE PAPER/JUNK MAIL: Any other paper. Keep slick paper separate.

SHREDDED PAPER: White and colored paper can be combined. No carbon paper, please. NCR paper is acceptable. Please bag separately from non-shredded paper.

PRESSED CARDBOARD: Such as cereal, cracker, pudding, Kleenex boxes, etc. Bring in an organized fashion. Flattened. Please do not combine pressed cardboard and corrugated cardboard.

DRY CELL BATTERIES: This includes flashlight, hearing aid, cell phone, camcorder, cordless tool and watch type batteries.

NO STYROFOAM OF ANY TYPE WILL BE ACCEPTED.

PLEASE BRING ITEMS IN DISPOSABLE BAGS OR BOXES.

PLEASE BRING ITEMS CLEAN AND SORTED.

NOW ACCEPTING ELECTRONIC WASTE (E-WASTE), INCLUDING ALL TYPES OF COMPUTER EQUIPMENT, ALL TYPES OF TELEPHONES, MICROWAVE OVENS, PRINTER CARTRIDGES, AND ALL TYPES OF TELEVISIONS.
